-  1 set of new tires enabled a young man to continue to drive his mom to her treatment appointments.
-  8 kids received support through CLIMB, a program for children whose parent or grandparent has cancer.
-  329 overnights at the Herring House, a home away from home so patients and their loved ones can stay close to the hospital while receiving treatment or care.
-  430 patients received financial assistance for basic needs allowing them to focus on their health.
-  700 SleepSacks distributed to ensure safe infant sleep practices at home.
-  \$1.2 million invested in technology, equipment and programs to ensure exceptional local health care.
